



## 2-Factor Authentication: Protect your organisation

Digital security within your organisation is important to ensure you protect details such as accounts information, network information and customer information.

2-Factor Authentication keeps logging into your systems secure by adding an extra security layer to the login process, this makes it harder for cybercriminals to breach your accounts.

2-Factor authentication uses:

- **Something you know** → For example, your password.
- **Something you have** → A onetime code generated by an authenticator app.

2-Factor Authentication is now accessible via your mobile device, you can use [Google Authenticator](#), [Authy](#) or [Microsoft Authenticator](#).

ITESP uses 2FA to ensure a secure login for your organisation. This is becoming an increasingly common cyber security practice, especially within Cyber Essentials.
