Cyber Essentials is a Government scheme that is designed to protect your organisation against a range of the most common cyber attacks.

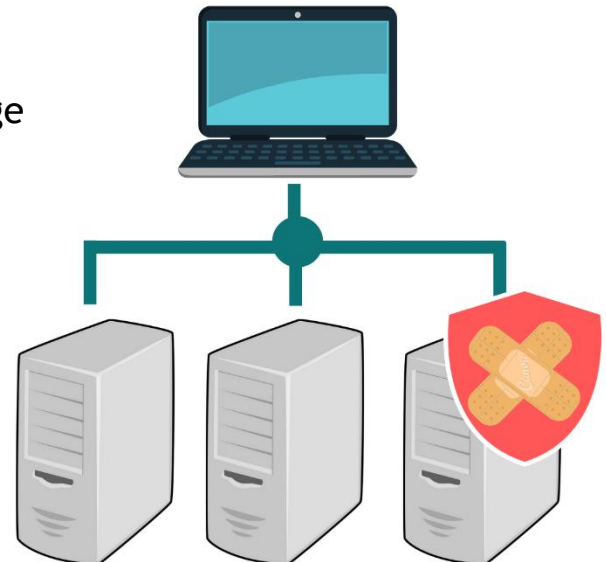
The five main areas of Cyber Essentials are:
